

2026 Camp Revisions and Updates:

- 1) No more “Late-Registration” or “Late-Fees”! **Registration will close after Sunday, July 5th**. There is no guarantee that student registrations can be accepted after that point.
- 2) The cost of camp will **NOT INCREASE** this year-- Praise God! The student cost will remain at \$255/student (family discount applies), and the leader cost will remain at \$125/leader.
- 3) **Medication at Camp--** To stay in compliance with state laws relating to administration of medication in camp settings our size, families will be required to submit their student’s medication in a blister pack, pre-packaged by a pharmacy. - 4) Youth camp is a week **LATER THAN NORMAL--** due to Hidden Acres adding an additional week of staff training into their summer schedule. **The dates of our camp will be July 27-31, 2026.**
- 5) **LEADER REQUIREMENT--** All churches bringing 3 or more students (of that gender) **MUST** provide a leader (of that gender). Groups of just 1 or 2 students (of that gender) will be placed with a leader from another church. **Central Region cannot accommodate groups of 3 students or more (of that gender) that do not provide their own leader!**
- 6) **PHONE POLICY (for students)** -- Phones and other electronic devices **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED at camp.** All students should leave their phones at home. **Central Region will no longer be collecting phones, and storing them while students are at camp.** Due to the increase in students at camp, the number of total phones that we are responsible for has grown beyond what we can comfortably manage. If churches feel that students should have their phones during transportation to/from camp– they may collect the phones upon arrival to camp, and store them with one of their camp leaders/chaperones during the week. Group leaders should make their contact information available to parents. **Central Region is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged phones.**
- 7) **Girls/Boys—Daytime Games Rule:** Boys and Girls will be split up during daytime games. This is meant to offer fair and equal gaming opportunities during our daytime games, which often involve a more physical dynamic. Late Night games will still involve boys/girls together.
- 8) **Girls/Boys—Altar Ministry Rule:** During each nightly service, there will be opportunities to pray and receive prayer at the altar. We ask that students praying together adhere to our prayer policy of boys praying with boys, and girls praying with girls (with an exception of students in the same family). We believe that this rule helps to eliminate potential distractions that might limit or inhibit God’s very best for the altar experience. Leaders and other Youth Chaperones are welcome to pray with students as needs arise.
- 9) **Cabin Inspection Schedule:** Due to growing numbers of students each year—Cabins will now only undergo 1 cabin inspection total (instead of 1 inspection each day). This will allow our activities crew more time to spend in each cabin for the inspections. Videos will still be made, and shown at the nightly services. In order to make this possible, a “Cabin Inspection Schedule” will be sent out weeks before camp—so that each group is ready and prepared.
- 10) **Summer Camp Cup:** At the end of the week, the team with the most points will be called up to center stage, and given the opportunity to hoist the “Summer Camp Cup” for all to see. A plaque will be put on the trophy and engraved with the team’s name, churches, and year. The trophy will be on display in the Airnasium throughout the week for all to see.
